Important Information about the Levy:

FACTS AND INFORMATION ABOUT WHAT'S ON THE BALLOT:

- Prop. 1 Replacement of Educational Programs & Operations Levy is on the ballot.
- Ballots will be mailed on April 3
- Election Day is April 23
- Ballots must be postmarked by April 23 or put in a ballot drop box by 8 PM on Election Day (there's a drop box in the Rock Creek parking lot!)
- The state funds "basic education." The actual cost to operate our schools is more than what we receive from the state. Local levies close the funding gap.
- Our replacement levies will maintain funding for our existing staff, programs, technology, and resources. Some of those include special education, safety and security, sports, clubs and activities, mental health programming, a portion of every teacher's salary, and hundreds of education support staff.
- A loss of levy funds would result in significant cuts to staffing and programs.
- The replacement levies on the ballot are 2-year renewals (2025 and 2026). Unusual trends in property values led the board to propose a shorter levy cycle because there is uncertainty in projecting property values 3-5 years from now. The board will continue evaluating what the right need is for our levy.
